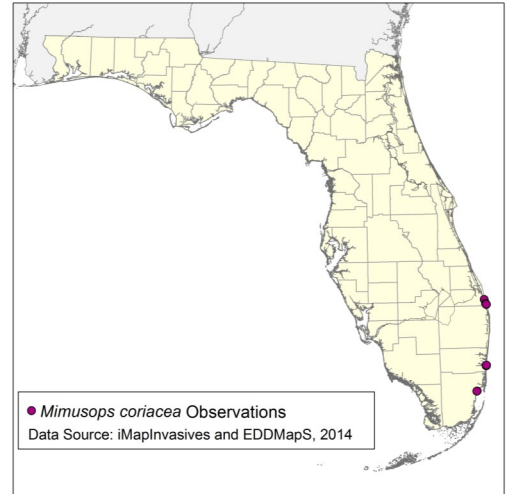

Description: Evergreen tree to 15 m tall. Leaves alternate, simple, entire, leathery, green and lustrous above, obovate to broadly elliptic, to 20 cm long and 12 cm wide, apex notched. Petioles stout, 1-1.5 cm long. Flowers born singly or in clusters in leaf axils, creamy white, 15 mm wide, corolla with 8 narrow lobes, each divided again into 3 lobes. Pedicel 4-8 cm long. Fruit ovoid, yellow to orange, 3-5 cm in diameter, seeds 1-2.

Note: Related *Mimusops elengeri* has leaf apex abruptly acuminate or blunt, pedicels shorter, and smaller fruit.

Habitat: disturbed areas
