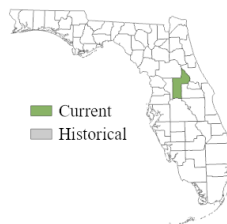


## FLATWOOD SILTSNAIL

*Floridobia leptospira*



**Order:** Littorinimorpha

**Family:** Hydrobiidae

**FNAI Ranks:** G1/S1

**U.S. Status:** none

**FL Status:** none

**Description:** This is a "moderately stocky", ca. 5mm snail (Thompson 2000).

**Similar Species:** Many other snails might look similar to a layperson.

**Habitat:** This species is only known from a single seepage creek and was found on "dead twigs, leaves and tree rootlets in quieter zones and pools along the stream edge." (Thompson 2000).

**Seasonal Occurrence:** This species is likely present all year.

**Florida Distribution:** This species is only known from the headwater section of Glen Branch, a seepage spring run creek, in Lake County.

**Range-wide Distribution:** This species is only known from the headwater section of Glen Branch, a seepage spring run creek, in Lake County, Florida.

**Conservation Status:** This species is only known from the headwater section of a seepage spring run creek, in Lake County, Florida. Anything that adversely affects water quality could potentially cause this species to become extinct.

**Protection and Management:** Manage the one known occurrence for water quality.
